Sub. :-Modified Red Flag for Level Crossing Gates (Para 913 of IRPWM and GR 16.01)

Ref. :-Railway Board letter No. 96/CE-II/TK/12 date 3-9-98.

To improve the safety at manual level-crossings, which is not interlocked and protected by signals, Board has desired that before openings of the level crossings gates for passing of road traffic, the gatemen will exhibit red flags towards the approaching trains to warn the train drivers during day and Hand Signal lamp during night on existing metal staff.

The arrangement for fixing banner flag during day is made out in drawing as Annexure-I. This should be followed on all manned level crossing during day time.
