A) Achievements of Operating Department Ajmer Division during 2024-25 Loading

- In the financial year 2024-25, Ajmer Division achieved a total loading of 9.57 MT, surpassing the yearly target of 9.56 MT, indicating an increase of 0.1%.
- In the financial year 2024-25, Ajmer division achieved cement loading of 4.91 MT, reflecting a 4.2 % increase compared to 4.71 MT loading during the corresponding period of previous financial year and 3.8% increase compared to target of 4.73 MT.
